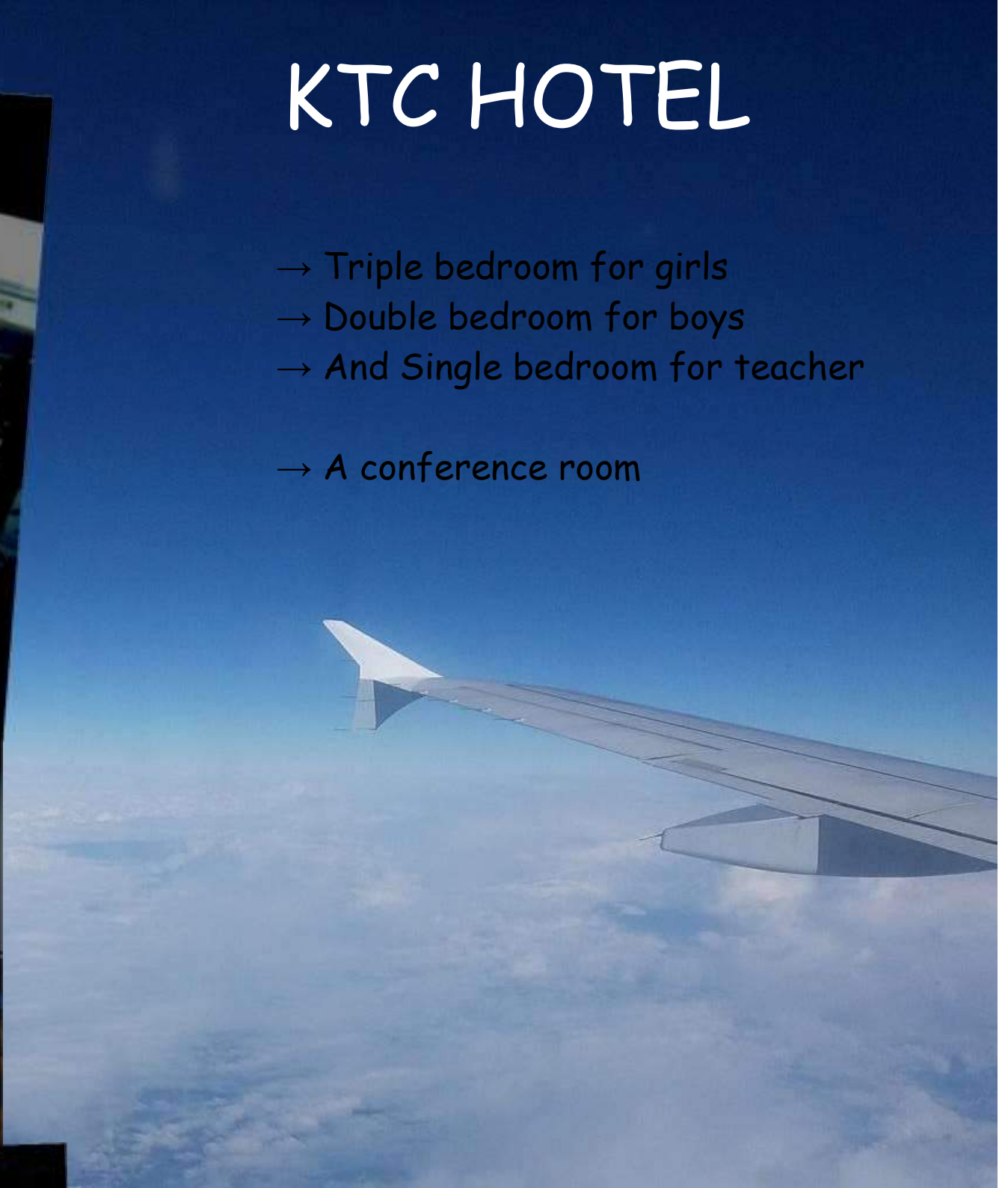

  - New project : since 2 years vineyard

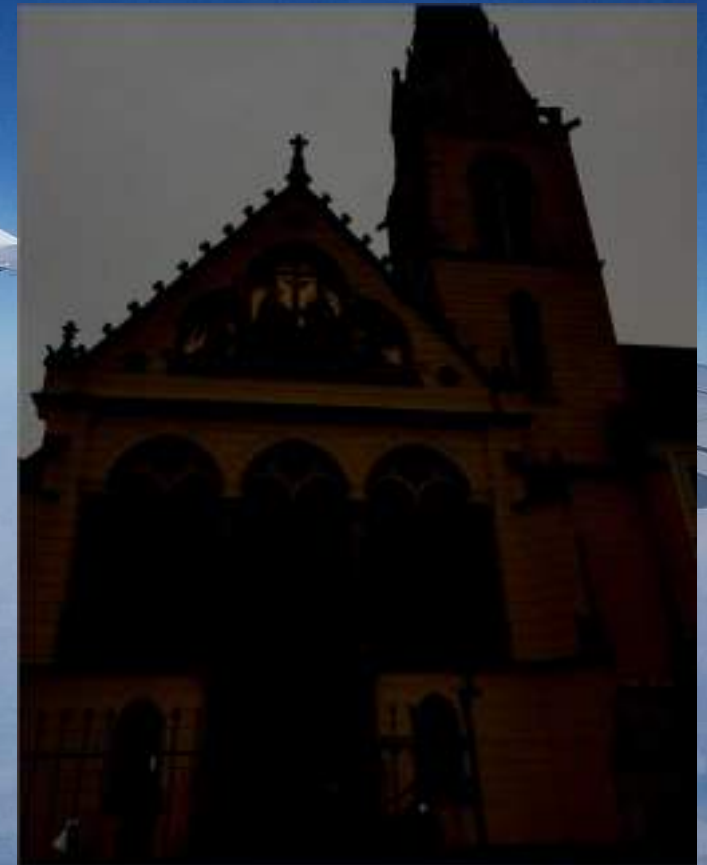
# TOURIST OFFICE OF KRIZEVCI

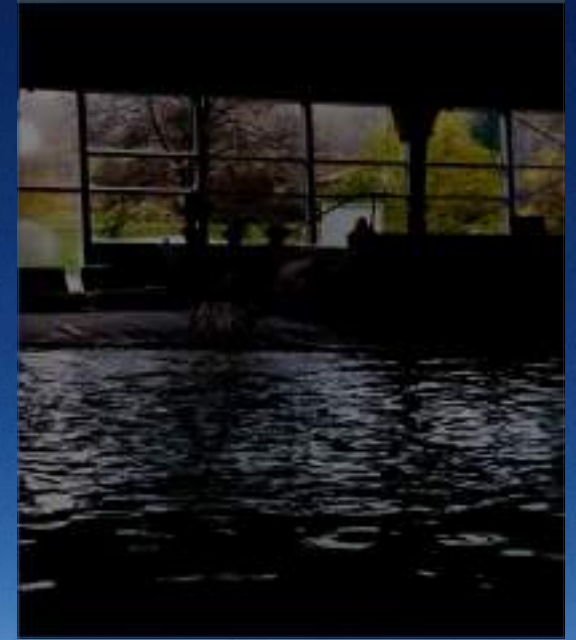

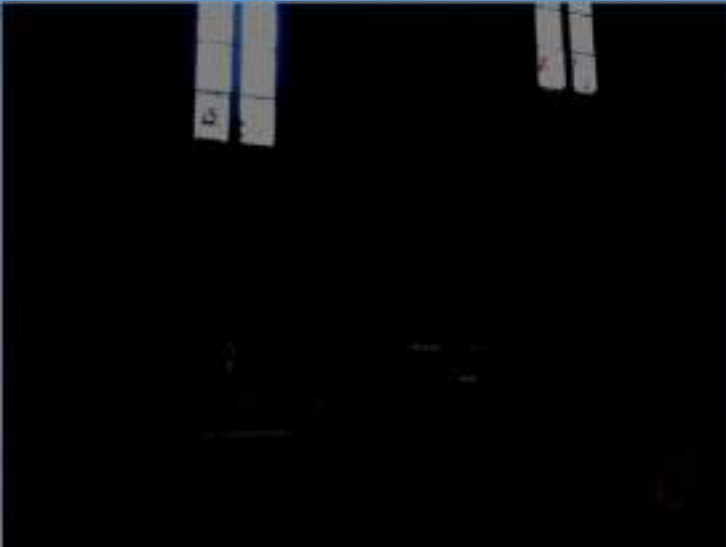
